First meeting in Barcelona

We Tomorrow is an intergenerational project where young VET students help seniors to improve their memory skills and quality of life creating Virtual tools.

Coordinators of the six partner countries met for the first time in Barcelona in October, 2018.

Seniors wishing to be part of this experience, and organisations in charge of them are welcomed from now, just get in touch with your national partner mentioned below.

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Objectives

- 1- Reducing school drop-out of VET students
- 2- Creating more attractive methodologies that will improve the key competences in VET: social, emotional, motivating, interactive relationships that link the student to a clear professional future
- 3- Promoting the entrepreneurial spirit of VET students by teaching them to create «Virtual Reality Packs» for «seniors» that can later be implemented and thereby open up new job opportunities and increase the employability of the students
- 4- Establishing an intergenerational methodology that encourages the collaboration and support of young people in vocational training the elderly population.
- 5- Promoting the improvement of the quality of life of this sector of the population due to the social and economic repercussions involved and because the attention to adults opens a growing labor market for which it is necessary to prepare young people to work in
- 6- Implementing the methodologies of three European projects :

«Virtual Class 4 us», project that based on learning in virtual environments. The «Gain Time»,

project promotes the methodology, «Flipped» that will be used in this project and the «Sharing is Caring» project that encourages the exchange of services among less favored groups

- 7- Involving interdisciplinary and international teams in the project, which with their feedback will facilitate the success of its implementation

- Eleven Virtual Content Packs aimed at elderly people based on ten cultural / historical events
- Creation of glasses with recycled material to visualize contents of Virtual Reality
- Five training videos to learn to
